

## Faculty Credit

The Prairie/HSHS CME program recognizes the learning associated with the preparation and teaching of an original presentation at live activities. Due to this, Prairie/HSHS CME may award faculty credit to physician faculty.

Faculty credit is calculated on a 2 to 1 ratio to presentation time and is rounded to the nearest quarter credit.

For example: If Dr. Smith is giving a 1 hour presentation, he will receive 2 hours' worth of *AMA PRA Category I Credit*<sup>™</sup>.

Credits can only be claimed once for an original presentation. If a physician is giving the same presentation at multiple different times, he/she will only be given the faculty credit for the first time it is presented.

Physicians will not be awarded faculty credit as a participant for their own presentations but will be awarded credit for other segments that they attend as a participant.

For example: If Dr. Smith is giving a 30 minute presentation during a one hour session and another physician is presenting the other half of the same session, Dr. Smith will receive 1.0 *AMA PRA Category I Credit*<sup>™</sup> for his presentation (faculty credit) and another 0.50 *AMA PRA Category I Credit*<sup>™</sup> for being a participant in the other physician's presentation.

Due to the reporting nature of our online CME software, faculty credit will appear as a separate session/credit than participant credit.
