How to Write an Effective Learning Objective

Your learning objective(s) should address what you desire to achieve from your professional practice gap and needs assessment. The objective(s) should be written from the point of view of your learners. To assist you in writing effective learning objectives, Prairie/HSHS has included some tips here you can use:

- 1. Remember learning objectives are not just to satisfy your CME requirements but are communicated to your target audience and any potential commercial supporters.
- 2. Use verbs that can be measured. A list of suggested/measurable verbs has been included on the next page.
- 3. Be brief and clearly express what the objective of your education is.
- 4. Make sure your learning objectives relate back to your professional practice gap and needs assessment. Are you clearly defining what your target audience will be prepared to do after the activity?
- 5. Ensure that your learning objectives are tailored to ALL members of your target audience.
